Project Examples

- At Fort Jackson, SC, we conduct and track NEPA compliance inspections of project areas and construction sites, conduct Construction Site Environmental Surveys (CSEs), and complete Records of Environmental Consideration (RECs). We also attend preconstruction planning meetings/charrettes, and conduct reviews and updates to NEPA documents/records.
- For Headquarters, Army National Guard (ARNG), we supported NEPA and ECOP services for all 54 states and territories. This support included assisting with preparing and reviewing NEPA policy and guidance; technical review of ARNG NEPA documents (EAs, EISs etc.) and other planning documents (INRMPs, ICRMPs, etc.).
- Whitetail provides full-time on-site support to the NEPA program at the U.S. Army Yakima Training Center in Washington.
- Whitetail prepared an EA for Gate 4 Visitors Access Control Center at Fort Jackson; helped collect forest vegetation data for endangered species habitat management and prescribed burns; assessed conditions of red-cockaded woodpecker (RCW) clusters and associated cavity trees; and managed existing habitat for RCW, game species, and migratory birds. We also conducted awareness training for endangered species conservation and compliance.
- Whitetail provides support to the Cultural Resources program at US Army Garrison Fort Carson, Colorado. Our staff supports the Section 106 process, performs archaeological surveys and site/field evaluations; provides GIS and database management support, and performs baseline site motoring and inspections.
- For North Carolina ARNG, Whitetail updated the INRMP for the Camp Butner Training Center (CBTC). The update addressed the baseline conditions of natural resources at the CBTC and provided natural resources management program guidance.
